BPI Building Analyst (BA) & Envelope Professional (EP)

BA is an entry certification for becoming an energy auditor or trade professional; qualifies for many energy rebate programs. EP is a specialized certification for measuring shell performance and offering solutions; qualifies for BPI Company Accreditation (required for Home Star Gold Program). Students may register for either BA, EP or for a discounted Combination.

BPI Weatherization (WHALC)

Weatherization is an entry level certification for becoming an insulation and air sealing technician and will qualify you to implement these measures in the field in improve thermal comfort and energy efficiency. Learn by hands-on training on how to properly install insulation materials and air sealing techniques to improve air quality and tighten the building envelope to reduce energy loss.

Energy Auditing & Contracting Business Development – Learn how to develop your BPI certifications into business strategies from the initial diagnostic testing to weatherization & retrofitting, quality control, and project management. Designed to help you understand how the house works as a systems and how to advise your clients on a scope of work and retrofitting priorities.
